Government Officials Accused of Voter Fraud in IL and FL

A city commissioner in Daytona Beach was arrested yesterday for absentee ballot fraud stemming from his re-election in August. [The Orlando Sentinel reports:](#)

Daytona Beach City Commissioner Derrick Henry and his campaign manager were arrested Wednesday on charges of absentee ballot fraud and voting violations.

Henry, 41, handily won re-election to the non-partisan Zone 5 city commission seat on Aug. 24, but he could soon be suspended from office following an investigation in which he and his campaign manager, Genesis Robinson, 21, admitted to fraudulently ordering dozens of absentee ballots.

Meanwhile, in scandal-plagued Illinois, the state Republican Party filed a formal complaint with the Jersey County state attorney, after a Democratic state senator was allowed to campaign within the polling location. River Bend's [The Telegraph reports:](#)

The office of general counsel for the Illinois Republican Party said it plans to file a formal letter with the Jersey County state's attorney about what it sees as possible election improprieties in the County Clerk's Office.

The allegations surround early voting that took place while the office technically was closed on Friday afternoon, Oct. 15. The GOP alleges that County Clerk Steve Pohlman erred by allowing both voters and state Sen. Deanna Demuzio, D-Carlinville, admittance to the office that afternoon.

Jersey County Republican Party Chairman Floyd Alexander alleges that Demuzio was shaking hands and "electioneering" on site and that Pohlman allegedly had left the room, the voters, and voting documents and machines unattended.
