## Wisconsin Still Ground Zero For Voter Fraud?

Last week's conviction of a former election official for voter fraud in Wisconsin is the latest in a long series of plagued elections in the swing state:

A former election official was convicted of voter fraud after pleading guilty to submitting more than 50 false voter registration forms in the 2008 election, according to the Department of Justice.

Frank Walton, a former Special Registration Deputy in Milwaukee, plead guilty Thursday to falsifying voter registration forms in June and July of 2008.

According to the DOJ, Walton submitted 70 forms as an election official in those two months but 53 turned out to contain false information, such as vacant addresses or addresses of commercial businesses. (Gillian Losh, "[Polling Official Convicted of Fraud](#)", Badger Herald, 10/4/2010)

The 2004 election in Wisconsin was similarly marred by voting problems. Following that election, the Milwaukee Police Department's Special Investigation Task Force unit released a stunning report that found an "illegal organized attempt to influence the outcome of an election in the state of Wisconsin" was made in 2004. Anyone reading that report cannot doubt that Wisconsin's 10 Electoral votes in 2004 were wrongly awarded to Senator John Kerry. More troubling, that report foresaw future cases such as the fraud conviction last week:

After nearly 18 months of investigation the Task Force believes that there was fraud committed in the 2004 Election, but as one investigator stated, '*I know I voted in the Election, but I can't be certain it counted.*' [Page 62, Report of the 11/2/2004 General Election in Milwaukee. Emphasis in Original]
