How Senator Reid Intimidates People For Votes: Headlocks & Coercion

National Review has obtained emails proving that Senator Reid's campaign staffers are working in conjunction with Harrah's hotel and union officials in attempting to [force workers to vote](#):

The Reid staffer then indicated that the culinary union had money available for more busses to take Harrah's employees to the polls. The Reid staffer suggests that Harrah's execs **"put a headlock on your supervisors to get them to follow through."**

...The Harrah's employee who forwarded the emails asked not to be identified due to fear of reprisal. The employee said the pressure from upper management was "disturbing."

"We were asked to talk to people individually to find out why they had not yet voted and to fill in these spreadsheets explaining why," the employee said. "I did not feel comfortable doing that."

"It put me in a very awkward position," the employee added, saying **the level of coordination between Harrah's upper management, the culinary union, and the Reid campaign was "disgusting."**

Once the employees are put on buses, they are further intimidated, FOX News' Eric Strawn reported last week:

There are allegations of voters being intimidated and menaced, this time in Nevada, that at least according to a complaint filed with the democratic secretary of state's election integrity task force there. Republican lawyers say they've filed paperwork alleging that **union political organizers do more than just – coercing and monitoring how they vote. One poll watcher William Rubins said when he complained the leader said the union member shouldn't get on the union bus it is they didn't want to be observed while they vote,** the team leader stated that it's not like they're taking anyone out and killing.

"Where is the Obama Department of Justice to monitor the threat of headlocks or the illegal observation of people voting?" said RNLA Executive Director Michael Thielen. "Is it that DOJ only cares about union workers when they vote Democrat. Let's hope the Nevada race is not close so problems like these do not make a difference in the outcome."
