RNLA Initiative Provides Presidential Campaigns With Ballot Access

Washington, D.C. — As part of the Republican National Lawyers Association (RNLA) Ballot Access Initiative, the RNLA will track and congratulate the Republican Presidential Campaigns as they successfully place their candidates' names on the ballots. "The RNLA Ballot Access Initiative was designed to 'level the playing field' and provide a resource of information for potential GOP Presidential candidates. We are excited that the vast majority of candidates have qualified in every state so far," said RNLA Chair Randy Evans.

Here is an updated summary of the list of Republican presidential candidates for the 26 states with expired deadlines to place candidate names on the ballot¹:

- All the candidates are on the ballot in Florida, Massachusetts, Nevada, New Hampshire, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, and Virginia.
- Jeb Bush, Ben Carson, Chris Christie, Ted Cruz, Carly Fiorina, Mike Huckabee, John Kasich, Rand Paul, Marco Rubio, Rick Santorum, and Donald Trump are also on the ballot in Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois², Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Ohio, Oklahoma, and Texas.
- Jeb Bush, Ben Carson, Chris Christie, Ted Cruz, Carly Fiorina, John Kasich, Rand Paul, Marco Rubio, Rick Santorum, and Donald Trump are additionally on the ballot in the District of Columbia.

The RNLA will continue to update this list and include it on its website.
