NAACP Has It Wrong: **Map Presents Evidence of Nationwide Vote Fraud Convictions & Prosecutions** *46 States Have Charged Individuals With Vote Fraud In Past Decade*

Washington, D.C. – The Republican National Lawyers Association (RNLA) today released documentation of vote fraud prosecutions and convictions in 46 states since 2000 on a new RNLA webpage at <http://www.rnla.org/votefraud.asp>.

David Norcross, Chair of the Republican National Lawyers Association said, “In just a limited study by one staffer, RNLA was able to find vote fraud convictions and prosecutions in 46 states. Yet, groups like the NAACP and the so-called ‘non-partisan’ Brennan Center continue to deny vote fraud.”

This week, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) issued a report entitled, *Defending Democracy: Confronting Modern Barriers to Voting Rights in America* which denies and misrepresents the reality about vote fraud. The NAACP made the false claim that “there is no evidence whatsoever that any noncitizen has ever risked the considerable criminal sanctions associated with fraudulent voting, nor would a noncitizen risk the even greater sanction of being deported.”

The RNLA webpage presents evidence that there were at least seventeen cases involving prosecutions for non-citizen voting since 2003 just in one state: Florida. The names, charges, dates are listed, as well as links to existing news articles or citations to cases, if available.

“The NAACP tries to claim that voter ID laws were passed only because of voter impersonation. Although voter impersonation is a form of vote fraud, voter ID laws were passed to also combat voting under fictitious voter registrations, double voting by individuals registered in more than one state or locality, and noncitizen voting. Instead of just listing vote impersonation, the RNLA vote fraud map tells the whole truth, encompassing all different types of vote fraud that have occurred in the past decade,” Norcross said.
